No Engineer of Gazetted rank or other Gazetted officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the State Government is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of two years after his retirement from Government service, without Government permission.

The name of work for which and the authority to whom the tenders have been submitted must be mentioned in the affidavit and he/she should produce his/her original registration certificate at the time of finalisation of the tender for verification of the license, failing which the tender will be rejected.
- 14. The scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe / Contractors desirous to avail the facility of preference as per Govt. rule should enclose the copy of their registration certificate stating the fact of caste by their registration authority with the bid, failing which they will not get price preference as per above rule.
