1. Introduction, Bidding Schedule, Site Visit, Pre-Bid Meeting

1.1 Introduction:

1.1.1. Department of Steel & Mines

The Steel & Mines Department is the administrative Department of the Directorate of Mines, the Directorate of Geology and Odisha Mining Corporation Ltd. The Department works for the development of the mineral resources of the State and is the authority for mines and minerals development and regulation. It also encourages and provides support for value addition and end use of minerals in the State, thereby creating facilities for employment, Socio-economic development and fetching more revenue for the State.

The main functions and activities of the Department of Steel and Mines are:

- Systematic survey and assessment of the mineral deposits of the State
- Exploitation of the mineral deposits of the State
- Administration of mines and mineral concession
- Enforcement measures for prevention of illegal mining and smuggling of minerals
- Assessment and collection of mining revenue
- Study of the impact of mining operation on environment
- Formulation of appropriate environmental control measures
- Research and exploitation of areas and minerals for meeting the needs of mineral based industries in the State and Country.

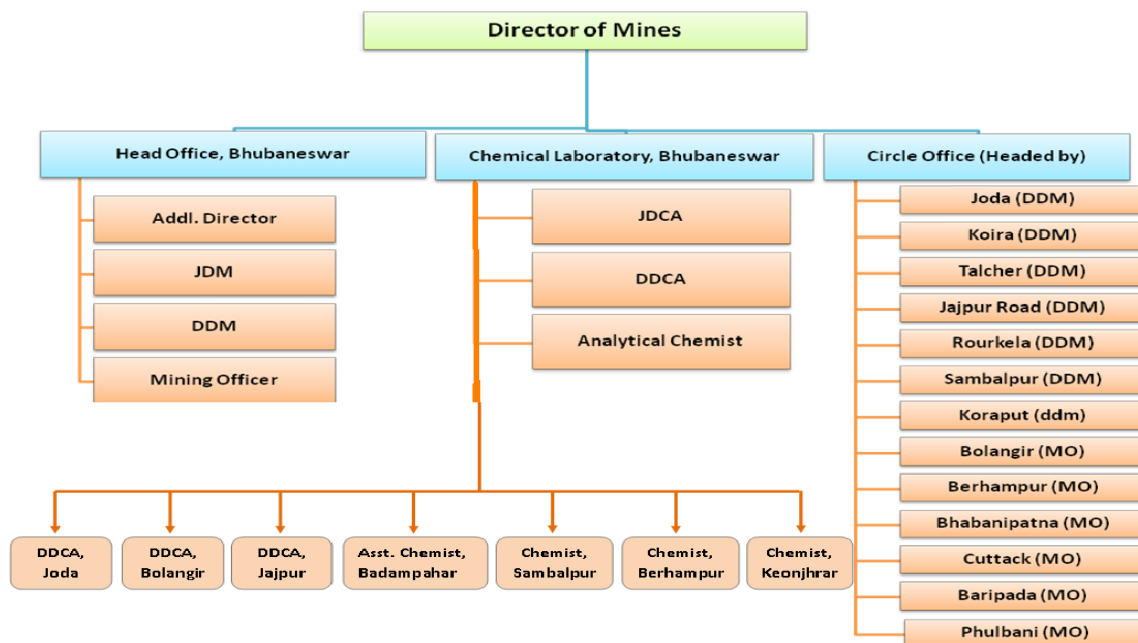
1.1.2. Directorate of Mines

The Directorate of Mines, Odisha functions under the administrative control of Steel & Mines Department of Odisha. The major functions of the Directorate are:

- Administration of mines & minerals
- Processing of mineral concession applications
- Collection of mineral revenue
- Prevention & control of illegal mining & smuggling of minerals
- Enforcement of statutory provisions for exploration of minerals
- Peripheral development of mining areas
- Chemical analysis of ores & minerals etc.

The Directorate has its headquarter at Bhubaneswar and carries out the administrative functions through 14 circle mining offices located in different parts of the State.

1.1.3. About i3MS

Integrated Mines & Minerals Management System (I3MS) was designed for effective monitoring of Mineral Administration in the State of Odisha. The seminal features of i3MS are:

- (a) End to end tracking of Mineral Ore from Source to destination (Rail, Port & Industry Head)
- (b) First application in the Country to have integrated with Freight Operating Information System (FOIS) of Indian Railways.
- (c) First application to integrate with the RTO, Vahan & Sarathi database in real time
- (d) 6 major Ports are integrated with I3MS to provide information of export & import of minerals.
- (e) Collection of mining revenue online to Odisha Treasury

i3MS enables the Department and other regulating bodies to administer, monitor and undertake activities such as issuance/renewal of licenses and leases, collection of royalties, taxes etc., issuance of permits and transit pass.

For mineral transit, the lessees are mandated to issue a copy of the transit pass to the driver of the mineral carrying vehicle as per provision of the Odisha Prevention of Theft, Smuggling & Illegal Mining and Regulation of the Possession, Storage, Trading And Transportation” Rules 2007 – OMPTS-2007. The transit pass is required to be produced as an evidence of legal mineral transportation to the en-route surveillance squad and the check-gate operators for validation.

The Department has established weighbridges/ checkgates at different exit points to authenticate the weighment of mineral carrying vehicles. The weighbridges/ checkgates are required to be maintained and supported 24 X 7 for effective monitoring of the mineral transportation in the state.

The Director of Mines, Odisha intends to procure the services of Repair/modification of 15 numbers of existing weighbridges/ check gates along with M.S bunk house, high mast light, DG mounted lights, DG, computers, peripheral items, other small electrical and networking, & stamping with comprehensive AMC at different mining circles under the Directorate of Mines, Govt. of Odisha.

The Director of Mines, Odisha invites tenders for Repair/modification of 15 numbers of existing weighbridges/ check gates. Each weighbridge/ Checkgate is installed / fitted with M.S bunk house (pre-fabricated cabin), high mast light, DG mounted lights, DG, Fans, computers, peripheral items, other small electrical and networking, & stamping of weighbridge from legal metrology with comprehensive AMC along with spare parts as per the detailed specification given in the tender schedule including Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract of the Weigh Bridges. Initially the contract period would be for a period of one year (01 year). If the performance is satisfactory the contract period may be extended up to 5 years with same terms & conditions without any price escalation.

2. Submission of Tender, Availability

2.1 Submission of Tender

The tender shall be submitted in two parts in two separate sealed envelopes.

PART-I – TECHNO-COMMERCIAL BID.

PART-II- PRICE BID.

The above two envelopes shall be covered in a third envelope super scribing “tender for Repair/Modification of 15 numbers of existing weighbridges/ check gates along with M.S bunk house, high mast light, DG mounted lights, DG, computers, peripheral items, other small electrical and networking, & stamping with comprehensive AMC ”, Tender Number and due date of opening and complete address of the Tenderer. The tender must be initialed with seal on each page by the bidder. The price bid should be type written; no hand written price bid shall be accepted. All the pages of documents submitted must be numbered and an index page should be submitted in the Techno-Commercial bid.

2.2 Source, Availability and Submission of tender.

The tender document is to be downloaded from the web site i.e. www.odishaminerals.gov.in or from the web site of the Govt. of Odisha i.e. www.orissa.gov.in from 06.07.2021. The last date for submission of the tender is 26.07. 2021 up to **3.00P.M.**, which shall be opened on the same day at **4.00 PM.**

There will be no manual sale of the tender paper.

Updates on the tender:

The participating agencies are required to visit the www.odishaminerals.gov.in website for updated information on the above tender.

2.3 Procedure, Date, Time and Place for Submission of the bid.

The bid should be submitted within the stipulated date and time in the tender box placed in the Directorate of Mines, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

The bids or modification to bids which are received after the due time and date of bids shall not be taken into consideration.

2.4 Date, Time and place of opening of the bid and bid evaluation.

The techno commercial bid shall be opened in presence of the bidders or their duly authorized representatives, if any, on 26.07.2021 at 4.00 P.M, but their absence shall not be bar to opening of the tender at the time fixed there for.

The techno commercial bids shall be evaluated by a committee and the price bid of the technically qualified tenderers only shall be opened in presence of the tenderers or their authorized representatives, if any, on a date which would be intimated separately. The technically qualified tenderer, quoting the lowest price of the composite contract will be treated as the successful bidder and shall be awarded the work.

3. Cost of Tender/Bidding document, EMD and Security Deposit.

3.1. Cost of the Tender/Bidding document & EMD:

- a) Tender paper cost=Rs 5,900/- (Rupees five thousand Nine hundred) only inclusive 18% GST.
- b) Cost of EMD= Rs 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two lakhs) only.

The cost of tender paper along with EMD as indicated above shall be submitted in shape of DD/Pay Order/Bankers Cheque drawn on any scheduled bank payable at Bhubaneswar in favor of "The Director of Mines, Odisha". The A/c payee DD towards the cost of tender paper and EMD should be submitted separately in the envelope for techno commercial bid. EMD furnished by the tenderers not being successful after opening, shall be returned after the expiry of tender validity period but not later than 30 days of the award of the contract order, whichever is earlier without any further request from the tenderer(s). If the successful bidder withdraws or amends, impairs or derogates from the tender in any respect within the period of validity of his tender or award of contract, the EMD will stand forfeited. The EMD of the successful bidder shall be returned after successful execution of the work & completion of warranty period without interest. The EMD of disqualified bidder in techno - commercial bid will be refunded along with price bid immediately. The bidders being MSES registered with NSIC will be exempted from depositing cost of tender paper and EMD. The bidders in support of being MSES registered with NSIC must have to submit Govt. purchase enlistment certificate.

3.2 Performance Security:

The Agency shall furnish performance security to the Director of Mines for an amount of 3% of contract value in the form of Bank Guarantee in approved format from any PSU bank at Bhubaneswar within 7 days from the date of work order. The PBG towards performance Security shall be extended every year in case of extension of the work beyond the 1-year contract,

The proceeds of the performance security shall be payable to the Director of Mines, Odisha as compensation for any loss resulting from the failure of the Agency to complete its obligations under the Contract.

The Performance Security Bond will be discharged by the Director of Mines, Odisha after completion of the performance obligations by the Agency under the contract.

4. Eligibility Criteria

4.1 Eligibility criteria of Bidders

- a) The bidders should have Similar Work Experience having one work of value not less than Rs. 50,00,000/- (Rupees Fifty Lakh) only during last 07 years by the date of submission of bid. The work order along with the completion certificate/ in Progress certificate is required to be submitted.
Similar Work Experience: *Annual Maintenance Contract/ Comprehensive maintenance of electronic weighbridges for any Government organization).*
- b) The bidder must have an average annual turn-over of Rs. 4.0 Cr (Rupees Four Crore) only or more during the last 3 financial years ending on 31/03/2021. The supporting documents related to financial capabilities shall be certified by C.A.
- c) Bidders should have (i) EPF Registration Certificates (ii) ESI / Mediclaim Policy / Employment injury & Compensation. If the firm is having any type of Mediclaim Policy or Employment injury & Compensation other than ESI, then the firm has to submit an undertaking that if the work is awarded in their favour then the firm would get registered under ESI scheme within the first billing cycle.
- d) The bidder should have Permanent Account Number [PAN] & Income Tax Return of preceding three years, GST Registration Certificate etc.
- e) The tenderer must have established service facility and adequate technical manpower in the State of Odisha.
- f) The tenderer should have maintained a minimum of 10 numbers electronic weigh bridges in last five years of along with the related services for the comprehensive maintenance activities under comprehensive AMC. The evidence in support of the above is to be submitted.
- g) The tenderer must not have been blacklisted for bidding within a period of three preceding years from the date of submission of the tender as fixed above by any State Govt. or statutory entities. The tenderer has to furnish a declaration in his document, if not blacklisted.
- h) Deposit of required EMD and cost of tender paper except for those claimed exemption under NSIC.
- i) The document in support of the clauses in the eligibility criteria needs to be submitted by the bidder in the envelope for techno-commercial bid. All the document submitted in support of eligibility criteria must have been authenticated by the bidder with his signature & seal

4.2 Clarification of Bids

To assist in the examination, evaluation and comparison of Bids, the Director of Mines, Odisha may at its discretion, ask any Bidder for clarification of the Bidder's Bid, including break-up of unit rates. The request for clarification and the response shall be in writing.

5. Contract Period, Payment terms and Signing of Contract

5.1. Contract period

The contract period is 01 (One) years from the date of commencement of the work. The Contractor / Agency/ Agency shall commence the work within Seven (07) days from the date of issue of work order and shall continue the work for a period of 01 (One) year from the date of commencement of the work.

The contract period may be extended up to 5 years with same terms & conditions without any price escalation, if the performance is found satisfactory.

5.2. Payment Terms

The total contract value shall be divided in 4 quarterly equal payments. The same shall be paid on successful completion of the work submission of the relevant documents within 30 days of the date of submission of the bill.

5.3. Signing of Contract

The Contractor / Agency shall furnish – (i) Required Non-Judicial Stamp Paper; (ii) Performance Bank Guarantee (iii) Draft Contract Document within 15 days from the date of issue of LoI/ Work Order

After receipt of the same and due legal vetting, the Contract Agreement shall be signed.

5.4. Termination for default

The Director of Mines, Odisha may, without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of contract, by written notice of default, sent to the Contractor / Agency, terminate this contract in whole or in part.

- (a) If the Contractor / Agency fails to render services within the time period (s) specified in the Contract or any extension thereof granted by the Directorate of Mines.
- (b) If the Contractor / Agency fails to perform any other obligation (s) under Contract.
and
- (c) If the Contractor / Agency, in either of the above circumstance(s) does not remedy its failure within a period of 30 days (or such longer period as Directorate of Mines may authorize in writing) after receipt of the default notice from Directorate of Mines.

6. Scope of Work

The Directorate of Mines, Odisha have 15 nos. electronic weighbridges/ Check gates (10 weighbridges & 5 checkgates). These weighbridges/ check gates are operated round the clock throughout the year for verification of the mineral weight transported from the mines / plants whichever the case may be. On an average each weighbridge weighs around 300-500 vehicles per day. The details of weighbridges/ checkgates are available in Annexure-B. Now the Directorate of Mines intends to carry out Comprehensive annual maintenance of these weighbridges for a period of 1 years which may be extended for further period as per following scope of work.

6.1. Annual Maintenance of weighbridges/ Checkgates:

- a) The Weighbridges/ Checkgates shall be handed over to the Contractor / Agency with the existing system as is where in basis. The Contractor / Agency will have to continue to provide services for the awarded weighbridges/ checkgates consisting of existing digitizer, PC, Software & DG, Tower, M.S bunk house, high mast light, DG mounted lights, computers, peripheral items, other small electrical and networking etc. In case the Contractor / Agency feels the need to change any of the above items is to be done with their resources without any additional cost.
- b) The Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract period will be commenced within 07 days from the issuance of work order for a period of 01 year. The Contractor / Agency has to maintain the weighbridges/ checkgates in perfect running condition for the Weighment of loaded and empty vehicles throughout the contract period. The repair and maintenance of weigh bridge shall be carried out in a professional manner and with due diligence, skill and care and following sound engineering practice and maintaining proper maintenance record.
- c) Contractor / Agency shall ensure minimum breakdown time so as to keep the weighbridges in good conditions to achieve availability of above 98% for each weighbridge.
- d) In case of any repair / replacement / modification to weighbridge load cell, load indicator during the contract period, it shall be made without degradation of the performance of the weigh bridge by the Contractor / Agency without any additional

cost to the Director of Mines. The said repair / replacement / modification work shall have to be carried out during the non-operational period of the system.

- e) The Contractor shall repair / modify/ maintain the existing M.S Bunk house for the use of the weighbridge.
- f) The Contractor / Agency shall have to deploy a maintenance team for periodical, preventive & breakdown maintenance. The Contractor / Agency shall provide additional resources as necessary for all major overhauling, shut down and other repairs and replacement of defective parts and to maintain the weigh bridges/ checkgates. The Contractor / Agency shall ensure that specially trained technical staffs who is capable to handle the maintenance/ breakdown work independently shall be deployed at the quickest possible time.
- g) The Contractor / Agency is required to deploy one dedicated resource at each mining circle for immediate attention/ minimum technical support of the weighbridge/ Checkgate whenever there is any issue. He will be responsible for inter office coordination for smooth functioning of the Weighbridge / Checkgates.
- h) A preventive maintenance schedule shall be formulated and submitted to the Directorate of Mines / Circle mining office at the beginning of the contract. The same is ensured to be implemented by the Contractor / Agency. For routine preventive maintenance, each weighbridge will be allowed 01 day in a Quarter. Prior intimation / approval of Competent Authority of the circle office shall have to be obtained by the Contractor / Agency for taking one-day preventive maintenance in a month.
- i) Smooth maintenance planning shall have to be done by the Contractor / Agency in advance and in consultation with In-charge of the Weighbridge / Checkgate so as to make best use of the idle period.
- j) The Contractor / Agency shall be responsible for verification and stamping by the Legal Metrology Department, as per statutory provision of the weighbridge on / before date of expiry. Man power required during verification and stamping shall be provided by the Contractor / Agency. Annual stamping fees required for this purpose which is legally payable, shall be paid by the Circle Mining Office directly. In case of delay, the Contractor / Agency may pay the above fees which is reimbursable under submission of the receipt and any other required document. The Contractor / Agency

must inform to the Circle Competent Authority through written communication at least two months prior on this matter.

- k) The maintenance Contract is inclusive of all travel and other expenses of the technical personnel deployed and no extra payment shall be made on this account.
- l) The Contractor / Agency shall keep minimum inventory of spares to restrict the down time of the Weighbridges/ checkgates. All spares like Capacitor, Resistor, I.C, Diode, Mounting Kit, load cell and load indicator etc. for the weighbridge excluding steel structural is under the scope of the Contractor / Agency.
- m) The maintenance of steel structural and foundations of weighbridges are under the scope of DIRECTOR OF MINES.
- n) Supply of all Tools, Tackles and special tools/ Machineries etc. required for repairs and maintenance of the weighbridge including minimum housekeeping will be on Contractor / Agency's account.
- o) DIRECTOR OF MINES/ Circle mining office on request may provide Mobile Crane subject to availability on free of cost.
- p) All the weightment slips shall be generated through systems, no manual system is acceptable. The Contractor / Agency shall be responsible for integration of weighbridge/ provide support to integrate with i3MS software or any other software required time to time without any additional cost.
- q) The Contractor / Agency shall co-ordinate with DIRECTOR OF MINES/ Circle mining office for smooth generation of weightment slips.
- r) The Contractor / Agency shall not be held responsible, in case of any damage to the weighbridge due to natural calamity or accident. However, the rectification of the same is under the scope of the Contractor / Agency. The Contractor / Agency shall ensure the fresh stamping of the weighbridge by the Legal Metrology Department, Govt. of Odisha after repairing of the weighbridge. The Govt. fees for Verification & Stamping shall be paid by DIRECTOR OF MINES. In case of emergency, the Contractor / Agency have to pay the required fees on behalf the Director of Mines which is reimbursable under submission of the receipt and any other required document.

6.2. Breakdown Maintenance & Penalty

- a) The Contractor / Agency shall ensure that in case of breakdown of weighbridge (s) / Checkgates, the same has to be attended within 12 (Twelve) hours of intimation to the Contractor / Agency and the weighbridge (s) shall be rectified and put in to Operation within 24 hours of intimation.
- b) Imposition of penalty: If the weighbridge is not rectified and not put to operation within 48 hours of intimation, then penalty @ Rs.1000/- per day or part thereof shall be imposed on the Contractor / Agency for 3rd & 4th day and from 5th day, penalty @ Rs. 5000/- per day or part thereof shall be imposed till repair work is completed. The stamping period shall not be taken into consideration for calculation of penalty. The penalty amount will be recovered from quarterly due.
- c) However, when such penalty amount exceeds 10 % of the contract price during the contract period, DIRECTOR OF MINES reserves the right to terminate the contract and/or forfeit the Security Deposit.
- d) The weighbridges / checkgates will be operated round the clock for 365 days. The Contractor / Agency shall be responsible to provide the technical support as and when required without any delay or as specified in the above.
- e) The Contractor / Agency shall submit the following monthly reports in a format acceptable to DIRECTOR OF MINES along with the bill.
 - i. Satisfactory compliance to site order or instruction of DIRECTOR OF MINES if any.
 - ii. Inspection report (fortnight) duly signed by the Checkgate/Weighbridge In-charge and the Contractor / Agency or its authorized representative at site.
 - iii. Availability of each weighbridge
- f) The Contractor / Agency shall maintain following registers
 - i. Work Progress Register.
 - ii. Site Instruction Register.
 - iii. Complaint Register.

Apart from above Registers, the Contractor / Agency shall maintain other registers if any as per the direction of Checkgate/Weighbridge In-charge.

- g) Contractor / Agency shall purchase the required personal protective equipment (PPEs) at their own cost and supply free of cost to the workers engaged by him/her in

the work. The workers will not be allowed to work at site without PPEs.

- h) The Contractor / Agency shall arrange the required valid Entry Permit/Gate Passes at their own cost if any
