AUCTION SALE NOTICE(VEHICLE)

Term and Conditions pertaining to Auction Sale and disposal of the Vehicle

1. Earnest Money deposit (EMD):

A sum of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One Thousand) only shall be deposited in shape of Demand Draft in favor of DDO-Cum-Deputy Secretary to Government, Panchayati Raj & Drinking Water Department, payable at UCO Bank, Secretariat Branch towards Earnest Money Deposit. No bidder shall be allowed without such deposit of Earnest Money.

2. Date of submission papers with EMD: 15.11.2022 upto 5.30 P.M.

3. Date and time of opening of sealed quotation:

The Tender Papers shall be opened on 16.11.2022 at 12.30 P.M. in the office chamber of Sri **Bijaya Kumar Mohanty, Joint Secretary to Govt.**, in the presence of the bidders or their authorized representatives if any.

4. EMD Refund:

After finalisation of the basis of highest offer and the auction process

5. Procedure of Lifting the Vehicle:


The successful bidder finalised shall deposit 25% of the offered amount as initial deposit and the rest amount shall be deposited within 7(Seven) days from the date of acceptance of the bidder after adjusting the EMD. The successful bidder shall remove the vehicle with relevant documents pertaining to the vehicle (without tools, equipment and spare parts) from the site within three days from the date of depositing the full amount of bidden / negotiated money. Custody or safe guard of the vehicle shall be the responsibility of the successful bidder and no claim or complain on that account shall be entertained. On failure to remove the vehicle within the afore mentioned time ground rent @ 1% of the bidding amount shall be charged for each day or part of the day till removal of the vehicle from the said premises. If the ground rent so charged exceeds the sale price deposited the bidder shall cease to have any right on the vehicle and the amount deposited by him shall be adjusted towards ground rent.

6. Penal Provision:

That vehicle shall not be delivered to the bidder until full payment and compliance with the requisite formalities is made. In case the successful bidder fails to make the total deposit within the stipulated time, deposits including the earnest money shall be forfeited and the vehicle shall be disposed off as per the discretion of the authority.

7. Power of Authority:

The authority reserves the right to negotiate in case the highest offer falls below the offset price and may also reject any or all bidding without assigning any reason thereof.
