TERMS OF REFERENCE (TOR)

A. Study Background

Millets are nutritionally superior to most other cereals, making them a favorable crop to address the prevalence of malnutrition in tribal areas. Traditionally, millet has been a major staple for tribals and significantly address food scarcity during lean season when there is no agricultural harvesting crop on farm. The method of traditional millet recipes is easy to cook, mainly in the form of gruels, and occasionally as a mixture with few other vegetables, pulses and spice ingredients. Some of these traditional recipes include *mandia jau* (finger millet with broken rice, maize and barnyard millet), *mandia anda* (ragi flour with broken rice), *mandia tampa* (ragi flour with broken rice and warm water), etc. However, with the introduction of monocropping, easy availability of rice under PDS and influence of urban food culture, tribal youth have reduced their millet consumption among tribal communities of Odisha. Over the years, there has been rapid decline of millet cultivation and production leading to reduced grain availability for household consumption among the tribal communities.

The key research questions to be addressed includes:

- What changes have happened in the millet-based food habit of the tribal people and does it in any way influenced the millet production systems and land use practices?
- What are different millet consumption practices and traditional recipes in tribal communities (staple/supplementary/ritual food/ beverages)?
- What are the different kinds of recipes prepared out of millets and the special occasions when particular recipes are prepared?
- What changes have taken place over the years incidental to the consumption, conservation and propagation of millet varieties?

Objectives:

- Studying millet-based food habit of tribal communities in Odisha
- Assessing factors responsible for changes in millet food habit and the consequences thereof on tribal food security.
- Document millet consumption practices and traditional millet recipes of tribal communities.
- Assess the nutritional potential of the different millet varieties and the millet recipes
- Assess the potential of introduction of millets in supplementary nutrition programs, enterprise development, commercial interventions in popularizing millet products
