1. Introduction:

The State Blood Transfusion Council (SBTC), Odisha has been formed on 25.07.1997 in pursuance of the orders of the Honorable Supreme Court of India in the writ petition [Civil] No-91 of 1992. It is an autonomous, policy formulating, regulatory and implementing body in relation to all matters pertaining to operation of blood banks in the State.

The function of the Council is to inspect all the blood banks [Govt., Public Sector & Private] regularly for implementation of "National Blood Safety Programme". The programme and activities of the Council cover the entire range of services related to operation and requirements of blood banking system and transfusion medicine starting from grouping, cross matching, donor selection, collection of blood, proper preservation, transportation, utilization, component separation and aphaeresis including resources to lunch effective

motivation through formation of Voluntary Blood Donors Association by elimination of professional blood donors.

2. Instructions to Interested Participants:

- a) State Blood Transfusion Council (SBTC), Odisha, Bhubaneswar invites Request for Proposal (RFP) from eligible institutions/agencies/firms, who are indigenous Plasma Fractionators in India for exchange of tested surplus Fresh Frozen Plasma (FFP) collected from different Blood Component Separation Units (BCSU) in the State of Odisha.
- b) **Cost of RFP Document (Non-Refundable): Rs.2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only)** in shape of Demand Draft from a Nationalized/ Scheduled Bank payable at Bhubaneswar in favour of President, State Blood Transfusion Council, Odisha.
- c) **Performance Security: Rs.6,00,000/- (Rupees Six Lakh)** only in shape of Demand Draft from a Nationalized/ Scheduled Bank payable at Bhubaneswar in favour of President, State Blood Transfusion Council, Odisha of the successful RFP participant. The performance security amount shall be returned to the successful organization /agency/firm after completion of the contract period with the stipulated terms in the MoU to be executed with prospective Agency / Firm / organization.
- d) At present, there are 30 nos. of BCSUs (**Annexure I**) functioning in Odisha.
- e) Approximately 40,000 ltrs. of tested surplus plasma are likely to be available for processing annually. However, it is likely to scale over the years to come.
- f) The price for exchange of surplus FFP is fixed at Rs. 1,600/- per litre (inclusive of all taxes). Participants have to give the undertaking in this context in the tender RFP form (**Format-T1**).
 - The selected firm shall make advance payment to the individual BCSUs in the authorized account provided by their competent authority equal to the contract rate multiplied with the approx. volume of plasma to be exchanged on requirement basis from time to time on collection of the plasma from the BCSUs.
 - The selected firm shall supply the primary and secondary packing materials as necessary free of cost and also bear the cost of transportation of plasma from BCSUs to the firm.
 - If any enhancement of price for exchange of surplus FFP is fixed by the Govt. of India during the contract period, the same enhancement price has to be paid the firm to concerned BCSUs for the purpose.

- g) Consortium and Alternative offers are not permitted.
- h) Tested surplus plasma shall be collected by the selected agency from different Blood Component Separation Units (BCSU) inside the State of Odisha as per requirement.
- i) The selected agency has to make advance payment equal to the contract rate multiplied with the quantity of plasma to be exchanged as per requirement prior to the collection of the plasma from the BCSUs.

4. Compliant Proposals / Completeness of Response:

Applicants are advised to study all instructions, forms, terms and conditions, requirements and other information in the documents carefully. Submission of the proposal shall be deemed to have been done after careful study and examination of the document with full understanding of its implications.

Failure to comply with the requirements of this paragraph may render the proposal as non-

compliant and the proposal may be rejected.

Applicants must:

- a) Include all documents specified in this RFP,
- b) Follow the format of this document and respond to each element in the order as set out in this document,
- c) Comply with all requirements as set out in this document.

5. Objective:

The basic objective of this Request for Proposal (RFP) is to select an institution /agency / firm for exchange of surplus Fresh Frozen Plasma (FFP) collected from different Blood Component Separation Units (BCSUs) in the State of Odisha.

6. Scope of Work:

The selected institution /agency / firm shall be responsible for–

- a) Collection of tested surplus Fresh Frozen Plasma (FFP) from different Blood Component Separation Units (BCSUs) in the State of Odisha.
- b) Exchange of surplus Fresh Frozen Plasma (FFP) collected from different Blood Component Separation Units (BCSUs) in the State of Odisha.
- c) Cost of secondary packing materials and logistics, which are to be borne by the agency and the agency has to take delivery/ transportation from the Blood Centres sites at its own cost & arrangement.

7. Eligibility Criteria/Documents to be Submitted for Participating in the RFP:

Institutions /Agencies /Firms wishing to participate in the Request for Proposal (RFP) must have/ are required to submit-

- a) Submission of Cost of RFP Document.
- b) Submission of Performance Security declaration in the Technical offer **Format T-7**.
- c) License to manufacture and store blood products for sale or distribution. (Self-attested copy of valid Drug License in Form 28 E and subsequent up to date renewal if any in Form 26-I with list of items of blood products permitted therein to be furnished). Up-to-date License copy to be certified by the concerned State licensing Authority along with the product approval list.
- d) The firm should have own Plasma Fraction Unit in India with 6 lakh ltr capacity annually for fractionation. (Self-attested copy of documentary evidence to be furnished).
- e) Valid NOC from Drug Controller General, India for collection /procurement of excess/ surplus FFP from licensed Blood Banks. (Self-attested copy of NOC issued in favour of the agency by Drug Controller General, India to be furnished).

- f) **Up-to-date** “No Conviction Certificate” from concerned State Licensing Authority from where license has been issued. (Self-attested copy of such No Conviction Certificate to be furnished).
- g) Details of blood products to be manufactured from the surplus FFP. (Such details to be furnished).
- h) No. of batches of blood products manufactured from the surplus FFP in the last Financial Year 2024-2025. (Self-attested copies of Batch Release Certificates issued by NIB, Noida to be furnished and submitted).
- i) Undertaking for utilization of surplus FFP to manufacture related blood products to fulfill the needs of Indian market first and none of the products recovered from the Indian Plasma should be exported before fulfilling domestic demand. (An Undertaking to be furnished).
- j) Affidavit that the agency has not been blacklisted / EMD/Performance security forfeited by the Government of India, State Government or any other Government owned agency including quasi-Government sector organization or company for corrupt, fraudulent practices or reasons related to non-performance in an engagement on the date of opening of RFP. (Self-attested copy of Affidavit duly attested by Notary Public to be furnished).
- k) Registration under GST. (Self-attested copy of GST Registration Certificate to be furnished).
- l) The RFP submitted by the Organization /firm should have a minimum annual turnover of **Rs.50 crore** in each year for last three consecutive years. Proof documents should be enclosed.
- m) The organization /firm will have to submit an undertaking for providing factor VII, VIII, IX or any other plasma product under its CSR /Welfare activities for blood disorder patients as per our State’s requirement.
- n) The Organization / firm have to submit the Income Tax Return Certificate for last three consecutive financial years (Document to be enclosed)
- o) The Organization / firm should have to submit the percentage of utilization of total manufacturing plasma derived product in domestic market and exported to other country for last three consecutive years (furnish documentary evidence as proof).

8. Submission of RFP:

- a) The proposals need to be submitted as per the formats enclosed in **Formats T1-T9**.
- b) The RFP document along with all supporting documents shall be submitted in a sealed single envelop cover which shall be super-scribed as “REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

FOR SELECTION OF AGENCY FOR EXCHANGE OF SURPLUS PLASMA". As the price is fixed as at present (i.e., Rs.1,600/- per litre), there is no price offer to be submitted in the sealed envelope)

- c) The proposal shall be supported by documents as listed in the **Checklist**.
- d) While preparing the RFP, the applicant is expected to examine this document in detail. Material deficiencies in providing the information requested in the document may result in rejection of the proposal.
- e) The applicants shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its RFP and SBTC shall not be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the selection process.
- f) SBTC is not bound to accept any proposal and reserves the right to annul the selection process at any time prior to the selection.
- g) The RFP shall be signed in original and stamped on each page.
- h) If the envelopes and packages with the proposal are not sealed and marked as required, SBTC shall assume no responsibility for the misplacement, loss or premature opening of the proposal.
- i) The proposal or its modifications must be sent to the address indicated in Point No. (j) below and must be received by SBTC no later than the deadline indicated in the Point No.(j) below or any extension to this deadline. Any RFP or its modification received by SBTC after the deadline shall be declared late and rejected.
- j) The agencies/ organizations /firms are requested to submit the **RFPs** through Registered Post/Speed Post/ Courier on or before **11-08-2025 up to 12 noon** at the address given below–

9. Confidentiality:

- a) From the time the RFP are opened to the time the selection is announced, the applicant should not contact SBTC on any matter related to its RFP evaluation. Information relating to the evaluation of RFP and award recommendations shall not be disclosed to the applicants who have submitted the RFP or to any other party not officially concerned with the process, until the publication of the selection announcement.

- b) Any attempt by shortlisted applicants or anyone on behalf of the applicant to influence improperly the client in the evaluation of the RFP or agreement award decisions may result in the rejection of its RFP.

10. Disqualification:

The RFP would be disqualified at any time during the technical evaluation process at the sole discretion of the SBTC for the following reasons:

- a) Submitted the RFP after the response deadline;
- b) Made misleading or false representations or suppressed relevant information in the RFP (including documents, forms, statements, attachments, presentations, etc.) submitted as proof of the eligibility requirements or as part of their RFP;
- c) Failure to meet any of the eligibility criteria as mentioned in the document.
- d) Failure to provide clarifications, non-responsive and/or substantive responses, when sought;
- e) Blacklisted by the Government of India, State Government or any other Government owned agency including quasi-Government sector organization or company for corrupt, fraudulent practices or reasons related to non-performance in an engagement on the date of opening of RFP.
- f) On any other ground as may be deemed fit by SBTC.

11. Right to Accept Any Proposal and To Reject Any or All Proposals:

SBTC reserves the right to accept or reject any RFP, and to annul the evaluation process and reject all proposals at any time prior to award of contract, without liability or any obligation and without assigning any reason or any obligation to inform the affected proposal or applicants of the grounds for SBTC action.

- i. **After verification of the offered documents, if any discrepancy, deficiencies and false information found, then the authority reserves the right to reject the offers of the firm / agency.**

12. Method of Selection:

- a) A Committee constituted by the SBTC shall carry out a detailed evaluation of the proposals received by it in order to determine whether they are substantially responsive to the requirements set forth in the proposal. In order to reach such a determination, the committee shall examine the information supplied by the applicants and shall evaluate the same as per the eligibility criteria specified in this RFP. In-ability to submit requisite supporting documents/ documentary evidence, may lead to rejection.

- b) As this is a fixed cost based selection, there is no financial offer.
- c) The technical proposals shall be evaluated in two stages:- i) Pre-eligibility criteria and ii) Award of Marks.
- d) The Committee may seek clarifications from the participants on their proposals.
- e) The proposal of the interested participants who qualify in the 1st stage of technical evaluation (Pre-eligibility criteria) based on the information furnished in their offers shall be eligible for the 2nd stage of evaluation, i.e., Award of Marks.
- f) The Participant who qualifies in the 1st stage of technical evaluation and secures highest mark in the 2nd stage evaluation, i.e., Award of Marks as per the criteria mentioned below, shall be selected.

Note: The criteria of award of Marks shall be as follows:

The highest turnover/ Percentage of performance as at item no-3 /No. of work orders (based on the information provided by the RFP participant in their offer) shall be awarded full marks against that parameter as mentioned above and comparatively lesser turnover/ No. of work orders executed, shall be awarded marks proportionately.

- g) Preference will be given during selection of an agency conducting such type of CSR activities /Welfare activities specifically in development of Blood Transfusion service either inside or outside the State for last three consecutive financial years as per Format-T8 (Documentary evidence as a proof of such CSR activity is to be enclosed).
- h) In case more than one interested agencies score the same mark and satisfy the selection criteria, then the eligible agencies shall be allowed to collect the tested surplus plasma equitably from different BCSUs.

13. Award of Contract:

- a) The agency shall be selected as per the criteria mentioned in clause 12.
- b) The selected agency shall enter in to a contract with SBTC, Odisha, Bhubaneswar within 15days from the date of receipt of letter from SBTC, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

14. Duration of Contract:

The contract shall be initially for a period of two (2) years from the date of signing of Contract, which may be renewed for another year subject to satisfactory performance of the Agency and with the mutual consent of both the parties.

15. Amendment to Contract:

Any amendment or modification to the contract can be made upon the mutual consent of both the parties and has to be made in writing.

16. Termination of Contract:

Either party may terminate the contract by giving a prior notice of at least 60 days to the other party without giving any reason whatsoever.
