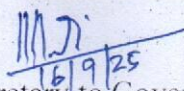

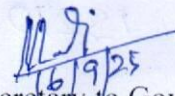

- 1.3 **Working Zones-** Venue where works to be carried out are Airport, State Convention Hall Lok Seva Bhawan, Mayfair Convention Centre, and such other Hotels to be mentioned later.

A. General

1. The selected agency will be required to liaison with the Authority of the Venues & Law Department and ensure all necessary approval for arrangements of the event in adherence to timelines, compliance to safety guidelines, its dismantling, and other pertinent activities mentioned under the Scope of Work.

3. The Selected Agency must adhere to the guidelines/Advisory of the related Venues.
4. The Event Partner will be required to share the indicative Designs of the arrangements for 2nd National conference on Mediation. The agencies are expected to use their creativity and suggest suitable design according to the needs and theme of the event.
5. If any extra items or arrangements are required above and over the scope of work, the agency has to provide instantly/ immediately without any hesitation & the extra amount will be paid on proportionate basis basing on the price quoted against the listed items.

B. Eligibility Criteria

D. Evaluation Criteria

1. The evaluation will be done as per the Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method. The technical component will be scored on a total of 70 Marks, and 30 Marks will be awarded to the financial component score.
2. All the bidders who qualify the eligibility criteria shall be invited to make a short power point presentation (at Conference Hall of Law Department) on Concept and Design of Venues, Effective Utilisation of space in the Venues and Innovative Ideas and other attractions in the Venues. The above factors will be evaluated by Tender Evaluation Committee. The decision of the evaluation committee shall be final & binding.
