Sub: **General Elections to Legislative Assemblies of Kerela, 2026 – PAID HOLIDAY - regarding.**

Sir,

In inviting a reference to the subject cited above, I am directed to enclose herewith the letter dt.20.03.2026 of the Chief Electoral Officer, Kerela along with its enclosures (instructions of ECI) relating to grant of paid holiday to employees who are working in Odisha and entitled to vote at elections to the Legislative Assembly of Kerela on the day of poll i.e. on **09.04.2026 (Thursday)**.

It is to mention here that Section 135 B of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 provides grant of paid holiday to the employees on the day of poll. The provisions under the said Section require that all employees of establishments and shops including those who work on shift basis shall be granted a paid holiday on the day of poll in the constituency where an election is to be held. Further, there may be cases where a person who is ordinarily a resident of the Constituency and registered as an elector, may be serving / employed in an industrial undertaking or an establishment located outside the constituency having an election. It is clarified that in such a situation, even those electors including casual workers working outside the constituency concerned would be entitled to the benefit of a paid holiday extended under the Section 135B (1) of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 and the daily wage/casual workers are also entitled for a holiday and wages on poll day as provided in Section 135B of the R.P.Act, 1951.

Sub: Election Department - General Election to Kerala Legislative Assembly, 2026 - **Grant of paid holiday to employees who are electors of Kerala on 09.04.2026 (Thursday), the day of poll** - Election Commission's instructions - Communicated.

I am to invite your attention to the references cited and to apprise that the Commission has announced the schedule for General Elections to Kerala Legislative Assembly vide its press note referred to at (1) above. The date of poll for the General Election has been fixed on **09.04.2026 (Thursday)**.

2. The Election Commission of India has directed vide its letter referred to at (2) above, that all the electors who are employees of establishments and shops including those work on shift basis shall be granted a paid holiday on the day of poll in the Constituency where the

General Election to Legislative Assembly is to be held. Further, there may be cases where a person is ordinarily a resident of the Constituency and registered as an elector, may be serving/employed in an industrial undertaking or an establishment located outside the Constituency having General poll. It is clarified that in such a situation, even those electors including casual workers working outside the constituency concerned would be entitled to the benefit of a paid holiday extended under the Section 135B (1) of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 and the daily wage/casual workers are also entitled for a holiday and wages on poll day as provided in Section 135B of the R.P.Act, 1951.

3. Hence, I am to request you to kindly take up the matter with concerned authorities in your State/U.T. and arrange for the issuance of orders Granting Paid Holiday to every person employed in any business, trade, industrial undertakings or any other establishments and shops including those work on shift basis/daily wage/casual workers who are electors of Kerala presently residing in your State/U.T. on the day of Poll i.e. on **09.04.2026 (Thursday)**.

4. A copy of the orders issued in this regard may kindly be forwarded to this office for information and record.

Subject: General Elections to Legislative Assemblies of Assam, Kerala, Tamil Nadu, West Bengal and Puducherry, 2026 - **PAID HOLIDAY** - regarding.

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject cited and to apprise that the Commission has announced the General Elections to Legislative Assemblies of Assam, Kerala, Tamil Nadu, West Bengal and UT of Puducherry, 2026 vide Press Note No. ECI/PN/029/2026 dated 15.03.2026 available on the Commission's website under URL <https://www.eci.gov.in/issue-details-page/press-releases>

2. The date of Poll in States of Assam, Kerala and UT of Puducherry has been fixed on **09.04.2026(Thursday)**. The date of poll in State of Tamil Nadu has been fixed on **23.04.2026(Thursday)**. The dates of Poll in State of West Bengal have been fixed on **23.04.2026(Thursday)** and **29.04.2026(Wednesday)**.

3. In this regard, your attention is invited to Section 135B of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 which provides for the grant of paid holiday to the employees on the day of poll. Section 135B of Representation of the People Act, 1951 is reproduced below:

Section 135B - Grant of paid holiday to employees on the day of poll:

- a) Every person employed in any business, trade, industrial undertaking or any other establishment and entitled to vote at an election to the House of the People or the Legislative Assembly of a State/UT shall, on the day of poll be granted a holiday.



- b) No deduction or abatement of the wages of any such person shall be made on account of a holiday having been granted in accordance with sub-section (1) and if such person is employed on the basis that she/he would not ordinarily receive wages for such a day, she/he shall nonetheless be paid for such day the wages she/he would have drawn had not a holiday been granted to her/him on that day.
- c) If an employer contravenes the provisions of sub-section (1) or sub-section (2), then such employer shall be punishable with fine, which may extend to five hundred rupees.
- d) This section shall not apply to any elector whose absence may cause danger or substantial loss in respect of the employment in which he is engaged.


4. The above provisions require that all the electors who are employees of establishments and shops including those which work on shift basis shall be granted a paid holiday on the day of poll in the Constituency where the General Election to Legislative Assembly is to be held. Further, there may be cases where a person is ordinarily a resident of the Constituency and registered as an elector, may be serving or employed in an industrial undertaking or an establishment located outside the Constituency having General poll. It is clarified that in such a situation, even those electors including casual workers working outside the constituency concerned would be entitled to the benefit of a paid holiday extended under the Section 135B (1) of the Representation of the People Act, 1951.

5. The daily wage/casual workers are also entitled for a holiday and wages on poll day as provided in Section 135B of the R.P. Act, 1951.

6. In view of above, the Commission hereby directs that necessary instructions be issued to all concerned for strict compliance, under intimation to the Commission thereby endorsing a copy of the same.
